

# Weight Limit

## AVOCA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE NO. 9 OF 1990

"AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE IMPOSITION OF WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS ON DAWSON STREET, PLANE STREET, LEHIGH STREET, PACKER AVENUE, PITTSTON AVENUE AND LAMPMAN STREET".

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Borough Code, 53 P.S. Section 46202(17) authorizes boroughs, by Ordinance, to regulate the streets, sewers, public squares, common grounds, sidewalks, curbs, gutters, culverts and drains, and the heights, grades, widths, slopes and construction thereof; and to prohibit the erection or construction of any building or other obstruction to the convenient use of the same; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council for the Borough of Avoca deems it expedient for the public good that weight restrictions be imposed on the streets hereinafter named,


### BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED:

1. That Dawson Street (from Plane Street to End) shall be limited to gross weight that does not exceed five (5) tons except for local deliveries.
2. That Plane Street (from Main Street to Dawson Street) shall be limited to gross weight that does not exceed five (5) tons except for local deliveries.
3. That William Street (from Spruce Street to Plane Street) shall be limited to gross weight that does not exceed five (5) tons except for local deliveries.
4. That Lehigh Street (from McAlpine Street to First Street) shall be limited to gross weight that does not exceed five (5) tons except for local deliveries.


5. That Packer Avenue (from McAlpine Street to End) shall be limited to gross weight that does not exceed five (5) tons except for local deliveries.
6. That Pittston Avenue (from McAlpine Street to End) shall be limited to gross weight that does not exceed five (5) tons except for local deliveries.
7. That Lampman Street (McAlpine Street to End) shall be limited to gross weight that does not exceed three (3) tons except for local deliveries.

THIS ORDINANCE shall take effect thirty (30) days after enactment.
